



## BABYSITTING MONEY-EARNING ACTIVITY TROOP AGREEMENT

To ensure the safety of the troop, leaders, and children in our care all members understand that in order to provide babysitting services as an approved money earning activity, the following conditions must be met prior to approval:

### CONDITIONS:

- ☐ *Safetywise* ratio must be met for the troop that is babysitting.
- ☐ The child to adult ratio (5:1) for children in your care will be followed.
- ☐ The child to Girl Scout/babysitter ratio (3:1) for children in your care will be followed.  
*Example:* your troop of 5 girls is babysitting 15 children. You need the following number of people: 3 adults and 5 Girl Scouts.
- ☐ Participating Girl Scouts/babysitters have completed a recognized babysitter training course such as the Red
- ☐ Cross babysitting training.
- ☐ Participating Girl Scouts/babysitters are at least 11 years old and have signed parental permission.
- ☐ Girls will not babysit infants. All children in your care must be one year of age or older.
- ☐ Children with special needs must be independent enough to care for their own basic needs such as feeding and toileting.
- ☐ The organization, company, or group for which the troop provides babysitting services has proof of liability insurance.
- ☐ Non member insurance has been obtained through Girl Scouts River Valleys to cover the children in your care.
- ☐ A minimum of two trained adults in first aid and CPR will be present.
- ☐ The following emergency information must be written down and readily accessible to leaders and troop members in the event of an emergency:
  - family/parent names; children's
  - names and ages; instructions on how to contact parents including phone numbers and addresses
  - emergency consent for treatment, doctor's name and phone number
  - hospital name and phone number
  - Poison Control Center phone number
  - location of First Aid Kit
  - location of fire extinguisher
- ☐ No medications are to be administered to children while in the troops care.
- ☐ If food is served, information about any food allergies must be obtained for each child.
- ☐ All leaders and Girl Scouts should be familiar with fire evacuation procedures for the location in case of an emergency.
- ☐ Children will be released only to the same person that dropped them off. I have read the above conditions and my troop and I agree to abide by them.
