

BABYSITTING MONEY-EARNING ACTIVITY TROOP AGREEMENT

To ensure the safety of the troop, leaders, and children in our care all members understand that in order to provide babysitting services as an approved money earning activity, the following conditions must be met prior to approval:

CONDITIONS:

☐ <i>Safetywise</i> ratio must be met for the troop that is babysitting.			
☐ The child to adult ratio (5:1) for children in your care will be followed			
☐ The child to Girl Scout/babysitter ratio (3:1) for children in your care			
Example: your troop of 5 girls is babysitting 15 children. You need number of people: 3 adults and 5 Girl Scouts.	the following
