Activity #1: Set Up for Success

Materials Needed: Take Action Project planning sheet (from previous meeting)

Activity #3: Reflection

Award Connection: Links to multiple award steps

Materials Needed: (Optional) Snacks, beverages, other festive supplies

1. After you've completed your Take Action Project (congrats!), reconvene for a small celebration to acknowledge everyone's hard work, and to reflect on the experience.
2. As you enjoy your snack, discuss:
 - How did the project go? Would you consider it a success? Why or why not?
 - How would you measure the impact of your project?
 - What was your biggest takeaway from doing your Take Action Project?
 - How did your group work together? What were some obstacles you encountered? How did you solve them?
 - If you had to do your project over again, what would you do differently this time?
