## What is a Mentored Troop?

Girl Scout Mentored Troops center the unique experiences of Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) youth.

- Community-based programming
- Safe space
- Led by BIPOC volunteers
- Funds available to support troop activities



## Why be a Troop Leader?

Representation matters.

By seeing, interacting with, and learning from leaders of color, Girl Scouts see themselves as leaders.

## What do Troop Leaders do?

You'll mentor a group of Girl Scouts as they earn badges, get outdoors, and take action in their communities.

- 1-2 troop meetings per month
- New leader training
- 1 on 1 coaching and support for the first year
- No Girl Scout experience required
