Scenario #1: Managing Girl Issues

- 3. Have volunteers post answer on wall.
- 4. Read a few answers from the wall.
- 5. Read the solution.

Scenario #2: Having a Difficult Conversation

Materials Needed:

- Post-its
- Writing utensils

Steps:

- 1. Read scenario aloud.
- 2. Allow 1-2 minutes to consider and write solution on a post it note.
- 3. Have volunteers post answer on wall.
- 4. Read a few answers from the wall.
- 5. Read the solution.
